STOLEN BIKES

The local police have reached out to all schools in the Alpine, Moira and Wangaratta shires, to ask for assistance in promoting both bike security, and also recording of bike details. Below is a guide, including information that is extremely helpful to police regarding stolen bikes.

Do you know the details of your bike?

If your bike is stolen, useful information to have when making a police report is: where and when the bicycle was parked

- the make
- the model
- the colour
- its serial number
- a photo of your bike
- any distinguishing features



By simply recording these details, it will assist police in both identifying if a bike is stolen and finding the rightful owner.
