It was great to see so many parents in attendance at our Parent Teacher Interviews on Wednesday night. We have not been able to conduct face to face meetings since 2019, so it was so nice to be able to see and chat normally to everyone again.

Any kind of change, particularly starting at a new school, can be daunting and nerve wracking for some, however the students have had positive starts at our school.
